

ARTS CLAY & VISUAL ARTS – ADULT/TEEN/FAMILY

POTTERY AT RIDGE RECREATION CENTER

The award-winning Clay Arts Studio at the Ridge Recreation Center offers a variety of clay classes for beginning to advanced potters. Knowledgeable instructors teach the techniques of handbuilding and wheel throwing in class. Our spacious and fully equipped studio includes electric kilns, gas kiln and raku firing workshops. Classes are designed to be taken numerous times. Monthly lab hours are available only for current students for an additional fee.

New students are **REQUIRED** to attend the first class.

Clay/Firing Fee (approximately \$30) and tools (approximately \$14) are additional fees and can be purchased in class. Old clothes should be worn. Bring an old towel to class for easier clean up. Long nails (natural or artificial) are not recommended.

CLAY ARTS – ADULT/TEEN/FAMILY

POTTERY - ALL LEVELS Ages 18 & up

Classes are designed to accommodate all skill levels from beginner to advanced in a sociable setting. Wheel throwing, handbuilding and glazing techniques are covered in all classes. Classes are designed to be taken numerous times. Clay and tools are available for purchase in the studio.

Fee: \$88 (District Rate: \$70) 6 weeks (3-hr class 1x/wk)

FAMILY CLAY PROJECTS Ages 3 & up

These classes are designed for families to take together. Create a specific clay project decorated with bright Duncan Glazes – projects are holiday, event and seasonally based. Please check www.ifoohills.org for project descriptions.

TEEN POTTERY Ages 11-17

CREATIVE MOVEMENT Ages 3-4
